SCHOOL OBLIGATIONS

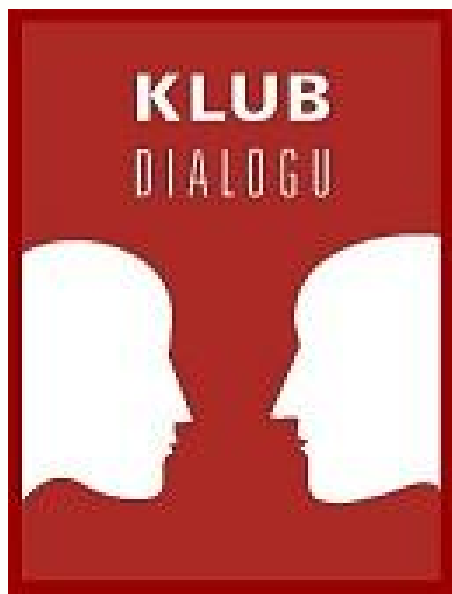
- The lesson schedule is prepared so that as few people at school meet with each other as possible

- For any request, during lessons, students may be asked to cover the mouth and nose (mask, scarf)
- The student comes to the lesson on time and immediately leaves the school
- Each student can only use their personal textbook and school supplies
- The student accepts that in the event of an alarming state of their health, they may be asked to leave the school by a teacher or an office employee. In this situation, the student is not entitled to a refund for the missed lesson
- If a student arrives in Poland, they may start lessons at school no earlier than two weeks after crossing the Polish border.

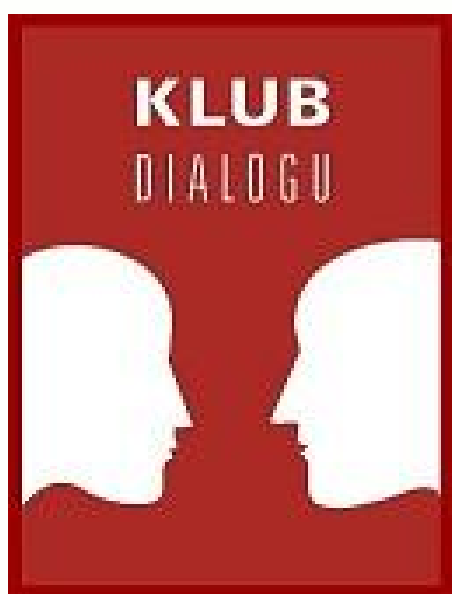
